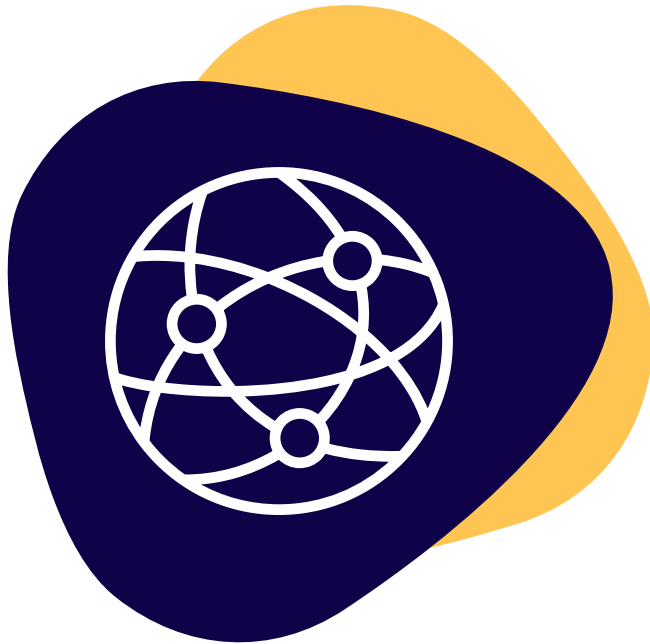

The Alumni Portal is a convenient online way to update us when you move, get a promotion, or want to adjust your subscription preferences.... or you can just email us. Easy!

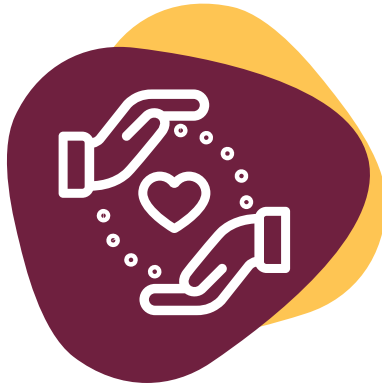

TIP #3 - Volunteer or Work here

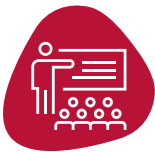
Everyone has something to contribute. Here are some ways you can help. Alumni bring a unique and valuable perspective to our teaching, learning, and operational activities.
